Use the opportunity to model corrections and shape proper speech and language skills.



### OPTIONAL DISPLAY & EXAMPLE PAGES ADDRESSING VERB TENSE FOR USE WITH SEQUENTIAL PICTURE CARDS:

Sequential cards can be sorted out onto one of the three optional verb tense pages based on the type of verb tense being targeted.

OR the optional collective verb tense prompt page and/or example page (both have light blue backgrounds) may be displayed while teaching all verb tenses.

#### POSSIBLE PROMPTS:

FOR PAST TENSE: "These things happened YESTERDAY. Tell me what happened yesterday in each picture."

FOR PRESENT TENSE: "These things are happening RIGHT NOW. Tell me what is happening right now in each picture."

FOR FUTURE TENSE: "These things are going to happen TOMORROW. Tell me what is going to happen tomorrow in each picture."



Sequential Picture Card story lines involve reasoning skills to determine the picture order and  
afterwards they set up perfectly for many different WH-TYPE QUESTION prompts!

While the cards are being put in order by the student you may discuss why and how the order is determined!

Samples of POSSIBLE Wh-Type Question Prompts: (Appropriateness of each question will vary based on the sequential picture cards being used. The clinician must determine the best questions to present.)

**WHAT?**

WHAT will happen next?  
WHAT did they just do?  
WHAT are they using?

**WHO?**

WHO did this?  
WHO else might do this?  
WHO would like to see this?

**WHEN?**

WHEN does this happen?  
WHEN did you last see this?  
WHEN would this be completed?

**WHERE?**

WHERE would this take place?  
WHERE might they go after this?  
WHERE was the (item) in the scene?

**HOW?**

HOW do you know this is next?  
HOW often do you see this?  
HOW could this end differently?

**WHY?**

WHY did this person do this?  
WHY isn't this card first?  
WHY is this person feeling this way?



*Sequential Picture Cards can be arranged to create a story line from start to finish. The student can describe the story scene-by-scene to generate a language sample and/or also display their sentence-level articulation skills. Use the opportunity to model corrections and shape proper speech and language skills.*

**SENTENCES:** For a written sample have the student put the cards in order on the writing page and write a sentence about each card in the story.



**ARTICULATION:** Ask the student to use a name with their target sound in their descriptive sentences to increase articulation attempts per sample. Possibilities:



As with most new concepts being introduced, prior to using these cards it is advisable to first discuss and explain all of the concepts of sorting and sequencing these kinds of cards.

### DEDUCTIVE REASONING

("Top-Down" approach to reasoning. Begins with a theory and narrows down through observation until confirmation.)

Show the client the first card of the sequence and ask them to tell you what they think will happen next. (For example show the candles on the cake being lit.) Show the next picture of the sequence and repeat the question. Discuss the answers they gave & the pictures that came out in a positive manner to allow for improving deductive reasoning skills. (For example you might say: "You thought they were going to eat the cake next, but we see they had to blow out the candles and cut it first. Why is that?")



### INDUCTIVE REASONING

("Bottom-Up" approach to reasoning. Begin with an observation & look for a pattern in open exploration of ideas to form a theory.)

Show only the first & last cards to the client. (For example show 'the candles on the cake being lit' card and the 'cake cut' card).

Ask them to look at the differences in the last card & then ask: "What might have caused this?" After discussion, put out the missing middle cards to see how the story line actually played out. Discuss in a positive manner, the answers they gave and the pictures that came out to encourage improving and expanding inductive reasoning skills.

**LONG SENTENCE BUILDING:**

If they are capable, ask the client to create one long sentence describing the overall story line of all four of the cards or a select number of them.

**IMAGINATIVE STORY MAKING:**

Mix up cards from different Sequential sets. Ask the client to arrange them in any order they wish, and then make up and tell an imaginative and creative story using the various pictures as the prompt to connect the storyline. This can be silly fun!

**BECAUSE THIS HAPPENED:**

Silly Fun: Ask the client to describe the story line starting with the last card and working backwards using a "because" phrase in between. They might say "The cake is cut because the candles are out." "The candles are out because the boy blew them out." etc.

**FLUENCY SENTENCE LEVEL PRACTICE**

Monitor & discuss fluency goals of the client in sentence & spontaneous language levels as they describe & talk about the sequential picture card story lines.

**TURN TAKING**

In a small group have clients take turns with each card in the sequence to complete all four with the various goals in mind (such as everyone gives a past tense descriptive sentence of their cards).

**LANGUAGE SAMPLES**

These materials lend themselves well to collecting language samples! Monitor the free speech generated as the client uses expressive verbal language to talk about the picture storylines of the assembled the sequential cards. **FOR EVEN MORE OPPORTUNITIES:** Try putting the cards in different incorrect orders to encourage spontaneous language discussions about why the order of the cards is wrong and could not work!
